

NOTES:

Dogs must be nine months old or older on the date of event except for the Instinct Tests where dogs can be six months or older and be registered with the AKC.

An exhibitor can enter both HT and PT in each event.

When not competing, dogs must be confined or held on leash and kept away from the livestock. Under no circumstances will dogs be allowed to disturb the resting stock or interfere outside the ring with another dog's performance in the ring.

The Texas Herding Association and the owners of Destiny Farm assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or spectators, or by any of their dogs or property.

BRING YOUR OWN SHADE TENTS AND CHAIRS, UMBRELLAS AND RAIN GEAR.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

In case of inclement weather or tornado or lightning, exhibitors are to go either in their cars or head to the barn with their dogs where they can be crated inside the barn. The barn can withstand over 100 mile per hour winds and is built to stay standing. Evacuation route is through the front gate turning left to head to Bertram or Burnet or Austin.

Bitches in season will be allowed but will be moved to the end of the class in tests and in catalog order as listed in the class in trials. Please notify the Test/Trial Secretary one-half hour before judging tests are to begin if your bitch is in season.

Notice to Exhibitors

- I. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent (unless replaced by an Alternate), disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Test/Trial Committee.
- II. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- III. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the Club organizing committee.
- IV. No refunds for duplicate entries. However, care will be taken to find duplicates before processing. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors.
- V. Checks that have been returned due to insufficient funds do not constitute a valid entry and will have a \$25.00 service charge attached.
- VI. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- VII. Texas Herding Association reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression, disease, deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dogs' physical or mental performance. No one shall have any recourse or claim against Texas Herding Association or any official thereof.
